**Research:** I have been actively involved in the research related activities for last several years. Organizing and taking sessions in faculty development program on research methods, writing research papers and review of research papers are my forte. SPSS, AMOS, SmartPLS and EVIEWS have been my main tools for data analysis. This helps me in enhancing my research acumen and assists me in imparting knowledge to others who come for my training programs. In the capacity of member of editorial teams of different research journals, my contribution is significantly high. As the head of the research and publication committee of the a few previous institutes for last several years I have significantly contributed. This includes: development of the research proposal, research projects and executing consultancy assignments etc. I coordinated a unique platform of faculty research seminars at several previous organizations. These seminars were conducted on regular basis which was a combined effort of internal and external resource persons with the sole aim of deliberations and development of research. People from different areas like agriculture, technology, architecture etc. were invited as external guests to support the cause.

**Teaching:** I have always been appreciated by the students for continuously using innovative ways of teaching. I have been very popular among the students for the unique ways of teaching which starts from the basics up to the advance levels. I am endowed with ability to connect with the students easily despite teaching relatively quantitative courses. I quite often get student feedback of 4.2/5 and 4.6/5 for the course like derivatives, and business statistics. This is the quantitative evidences to draw the same conclusion. I blend research along with the teaching to make both complementary to each other. I use lots of software and database to make the teaching contemporary and techno-savvy which is beyond the use of power points and MS-

Excel. For actively using SPSS and Prowess for the courses Investment Management and Business Statistics I earned praise and condemn at the same time by different people. I prefer to teach those courses of finance which are mathematical based. Despite that I have always found students crediting me generously for removing the fear of numbers surprisingly in their post-graduation course by my style of teaching. Most of the students shared that this unique blend of comfort while learning quantitative courses, they did not get in the earlier courses.

**Leadership:** Leadership comes handy to me since beginning. I found that academic administration is also my forte. There are only a few teachers who claim to be comfortable in all the three roles: teaching, research and administration. I have my list of accomplishments in all the three roles. This is the reason that I claim to be a better administrator because of my equally good output for teaching and research. I have held position like Program Director/ Dean for different programs. In my previous organization, TSM Madurai, I held the position of Dean of MBA program which involves academic administration including the role of controller of examination (Dean of MBA program is ex-officio Controller of Examinations for MBA program which is affiliated to Madurai Kamraj University (MKU), Madurai). The MBA program at TSM has been granted the status of Autonomous by UGC in year 2010/2017. This gives twin advantage of having degree of MKU but enjoying autonomy like any B-School offering PGDM affiliated to AICTE. This made my role not only challenging but demanded skills to balance different other roles I play as Dean of the program. I headed the Publication team during the International conference organized by SIBM Pune, Symbiosis International (Deemed University). We got two books published by Emerald on the abstract and full papers of the conference respectively. This added value in me to manage such a huge task of facilitating publication of 91 papers in different supporting journals and book by emerald.

**Collaboration:** I have been the head of the team for Compliance, Assessment, Ranking, Accreditation and Quality Assurance for more than five years at Jaipuria Jaipur. At TSM before taking the responsibility of Dean, I was spearheading NAAC, NBA and ACBSP teams for the accreditation of my program. In due course of fulfilling the requirements of Ranking, AICTE approval, AIU, NBA and NAAC I need to collaborate a lot with many people and their different bodies to get the required approvals at Jaipuria Jaipur.
